Outgoing Student Mobility | University of Arts Linz

Possible duration of stays abroad: max. 12 mobility months per study cycle (BA, MA; diploma: 1st / 2nd section), across all exchange programmes combined.

Erasmus+ Study (SMS)	1 semester; extension possible, subject to available budget and meeting the requirements.	November–December: Applications for the winter or summer semester. May: Remaining places for the summer semester (budget permitting).	Link
Erasmus+ Traineeship (SMP)	Minimum duration: 2 months Funding: up to 4 months Extension possible if budget is available and requirements are met)	Rolling, subject to available budget. Contact the International Office. Applications are only possible after receiving an internship offer.	Link
Bilateral Exchange (Study)	1 semester; extension to 2 possible	Apply for 1 semester; nomination by Kunstuni	Link
Erasmus+ Short-term Mobility	5–30 days (often with virtual part)	Application information is sent by the International Office once an offer from a partner university is available; there are no fixed deadlines.	Link
Short-term Mobility for PhD (Erasmus+)	5–30 days (longer via Erasmus possible)	Rolling basis (subject to budget availability). By arrangement with the International Office (IO). Requirement: Employment with the University of Arts Linz of less than 1.5 years at the start of the mobility.	Link
